West Melbourne 3D Printing in Schools

We are super excited to announce that Exford Primary has been successful in gaining a grant from the Toyota Community Trust that is being delivered in conjunction with Makers Empire. This means that Exford will be involved in the West Melbourne 3D Printing in Schools Project that is looking at implementing STEM learning outcomes and improvement in students' critical, creative and design thinking abilities.

As a result of this grant Exford Primary will receive:

- 3 x ElashForge Inventor IIs 3D printers
- 20 rolls of biodegradable PLA filament
- Hardware training
- Hardware support
- Easy to use software for all year levels

Ms Kappler and Ms Watt will be attending training in using the software and printers so that we can create a project for the Exford Community. We are looking forward to sharing more about the project with the community as we learn more about the process in the coming weeks.
