The kids are coming back!

Only one more school day and the children will be back at school! We can't *WAIT* to see them!

Please make sure that you read our [EPS Return to School Plan](#) thoroughly so that you are prepared and can follow our guidelines for a safe return to school.

Our Year 3-6 and Specialist teachers will have their Term 4 Professional Practice Day on Friday 9 October before the children's return. They will upload learning tasks loaded to Seesaw. The Prep - Year 2 teachers will have their day through Term 4.

Our focus will be on supporting the children to re-engage with each other and on their social and emotional wellbeing. We will focus on working with the children to identify the progress they have made during Remote Learning and assessing what their learning goals need to be and how best to support them.

We will support our Year 6 kids to be ready for transition to Year 7 and their secondary schools, as well as supporting our 2021 Prep children's transition to school. Our in-school transition support will also be a priority, supporting children move between year levels and stages of the school.

EXFORD PS - RETURN TO SCHOOL PLAN - parent information – updated Tuesday 6 Oct 2020

We are now in Stage 2 of the Roadmap to Recovery, outlined by the Victorian Premier (which I have previously sent to families through our Seesaw and FlexiSchools apps).

Our initial focus for all of the students is supporting their wellbeing as they return to school – reconnecting with their friends and classmates, re-engaging in their class and school routines and managing a school day which is different from learning at home. Our classroom focus will be on Literacy and Numeracy for Term 4, and on supporting their readiness for transition, particularly our Year 6 children preparing for secondary school.

From Monday 12 October, we invite all of our children and staff to return to school.

We will re-enact our 'Return to School' Plan which we used earlier in the year, with some adjustments. Until further notice, we ask that our families follow the information listed below until the end of Term 4 2020 (or until advised otherwise by Ms Campo or Mr Wilson).

We would like our families to drop off and pick up their children in two distinct groups, so that we keep adult contact to a minimum. We will put bollards out to prevent parking in the carpark spaces adjacent to the vehicle gates, which will help with pedestrian movement. We ask parents to collect their children and to move off promptly, and to remain 1.5 m away from other adults as much as is possible – this includes staff as well as other parents.



All adults are reminded that the wearing of a face mask is compulsory (unless there is a medical reason not to wear a mask). We ask that all parents and carers wear a face mask for school drop-off and pick-up. If parents or carers are unwell, they must not enter the school grounds.

Whilst we will all be very excited about the prospect of returning to school (adults as well as children!), we all must be very clear that we still need to be very careful and vigilant in our Covid-19 safe practices. Please discuss with your children, as we will at school, how important it is that they hand-sanitise frequently throughout the day, especially before and after play times, toilet visits and food times.



Term 4 – 'No Hat, No Play' – We are back in our SunSmart time and all children must wear their Exford PS broadbrimmed hat (no substitutes) during PE classes and all play / lunchtimes from Monday 12 October. The children must also bring 2-3 drink bottles per day, as the drink taps cannot be used at this time.


